





NOTICE

Make sure the printer power is off before plug or unplug the cable.





Please don't place the printer in humidity or dusty space, excessive humidity and dust may damage it.




Avoid external impact when operating, do not fall the printer down and avoid vigorously impact.




Do not plug or unplug with wet hands.

The print head has a high temperature after work. Please don't touch the print head or touch the motor shell in case scalded.



Paper end direction:


1. Push cover opener in order to open upper cover
2. Put the paper roll in the cabinet. Leave the slip end out of printer. (Easy paper load architecture)
3. Close the upper cover.

4.4 Self Test & DUMP Mode


1. FEED
Press the FEED button once to advance paper one line. You can also hold down the FEED button to feed paper continuously.
2. POWER LIGHT
In normal status, this light is on. This light will flash when there is any error or paper lack.
3. ERROR LIGHT
The light is on when Error happens to the printer.

1. Load the paper roll and switch off the printer. Then press FEED button and hold, then switch on the printer. The printer then performs self test.
2. Load the paper roll and switch off the printer. Then open the printer cover and press FEED button. Switch on the printer and then close the printer cover. Then the printer will print out "DUMP". It means the printer enters ?DUMP" mode. All data will be printed out in raw HEX format.

Notice: restart the printer could restore to normal printing mode.

4.5 DIP Switch

Unscrew the screw on bottom of printer and take away the metal cover as picture 4.4.
Users will find the DIP switches under the window as picture 4.5.


DIP switches could perform printer configurations as following: Serial port baud rate adjusting, beep alarm switch, printing density adjusting, parity selection (for serial communication), parallel printing server mode or normal mode adjusting, EPSON mode or Normal mode switching, Chinese Character double byte mode or English characters single byte mode selection.




4.6 Replacing the interface:

interface by users.


1. Loosen the screws as (4.6)

4.7 Interface Explanation


4.7.1 RS-232 Serial Interface

Printer uses 25-pin DSUB serial connector. Baud rate supports 38400, 115200,
9600, 19200 bps, 8-digits data, 1 stop bit, no parity.


